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Jasmine Morand's Interview

To strip naked, a mythological parallel

How couldn't we but establish the link between dancer Artemis Sacantanis' first name and the one of the Greek goddess? In ancient mythology, Artemis is not just the goddess of hunting; she's also the divinity of women, the protector of youth and the deity of physical and sexual development. She punished men who would try to seduce her or who were rude and disrespectful to her. This parallel adds a symbolic dimension to the question of baring our soul in front of each other in a couple's relationship, and what we reveal from ourselves. The playwriting explores this question of consent and our availability for being observed and for exposing ourselves through seduction as well as in symbiosis, where the couple's balance can ultimately be disturbed.

As in a lovers' relationship, the choreography suggests this almost immobile dimension based on the slowness of gesture, as it unfolds in a continuous back and forth movement between what was, what is and what could be; between the present moment and the memory of a gesture, or the future in the making. Bod-ies move in symbiosis or in opposition, in search of a balance for the couple, which oscillates between dependency and trust, the conviction of what is still possible and the fear of loss, games of power and submission. The physicality and maturity of both dancers, who are more than 65 years old, add a whole new depth to the gesture, wherein the simplest or most innocuous movement carries out a more intense emotional load.

Lui & Artemis explores a lovers' relationship that has been put to the test of time. In an elderly couple's relationship, what have been lived before become ever more present nowadays, and there's no longer any great expectations for the future. Even though intensity still remains, time is flowing slower, as if it was suspended, and a certain tempo is no longer required for excitement.

Gestures slow down and freedom of movement is progressively restrained.

Prototype Status

The choreographic research of Jasmine Morand, winner in 2013 of the Dance Award of the Fondation Vaudoise pour la Culture, unveils a personal reality that is always based on present and actual materials, while reinventing and intertwining them into a whole new structure. The individual is placed at the heart of the subject and, though a critical perspective is given on him and his potentialities, this perspective is nevertheless being amused. These sharp observations com-pose the framework of a repertoire comprising short pieces with refined topics, allowing a complete focus on the essence of the statement, the detail of gesture as in its signified and its line.

The Prototype Status Company, established in Vevey - Switzerland since 2007, receives an annual convention funding support from the City Department of this town and from the state of Vaud, since 2016. The company resides at the Dansomètre, a choreographic creation space in Vevey. This enterprise has produced over a dozen pieces, for soloist players or groups, which have been toured in more than ten countries. Among its most important works are: Frozen, Caso & Caos, Marvin, Aquarium, Série B, Don't panic, and recently the diptych Ground(s) and the performance PÔLE, which explore interaction with new media and technology. The venture has also done research on public spaces with projects Par-ours 35 mm and Blind Date Parcours, which were originally created for the Swiss nationwide dance event La Fête de la Danse. Created for the Festival Images Vevey 2016, the twelve dancer performance MIRE offers a scenography that opens up the field of visual arts. Her 2020's creation received the Label+ romand award, a funding from the Swiss French speaking cantons which goal is to finance and support major creative project every two years.

Born in 1977 in Zurich, Jasmine Morand completed her classical training in Geneva and at the Princess Grace Academy in Monaco, after winning first prize at the Swiss National Competition for classical dance in Solothurn and modern dance in Nyon. She began her dancing career at the National Ballet of Nancy and Lorraine, before joining the Zurich Opera under the direction of Heinz Spoerli and the National Ballet of Slovenia. In 2000, she began training in contemporary dance in Codarts, Rotterdam, where she began to develop her choreographic work. On returning to Switzerland, she founded the company Prototype Status.
